Our approach is to first provide information on the species, size and condition of trees; this information is used to determine which trees are suitable for preservation. Project plans are then reviewed to determine potential construction impacts and to provide prognoses for the trees to be preserved. In cases where infrastructure is planned within a defined tree protection zone, the location, size and depth of tree roots is critical information to develop prognoses and preservation strategies. For example, locating building piers or utilities to avoid root injury. Tree Associates is the only company that can now utilize its Tree Radar Unit to provide this information without excavation.
